Dear Mr. IGER,

I have been informed by Peuples Solidaires (France) of the death of a 17 year old worker who was mutilated by an unsafe machine while working at Yiuwah, a Disney-audited factory, in April this year, and of the widespread, systematic and serious violations of human and workers' rights at this Chinese factory.

I am extremely concerned by Disney's decision to cease new orders of any Disney-branded products in the Yiuwah factory until conditions are improved. I urge you to:

- invest more in goods purchased from Yiuwah;
- immediately address and correct serious violations at Yiuwah, in particular protect the children who have illegally produced Disney's goods; address worker safety issues; labor contract violations and forced overtime.

I expect Disney to make good on its word to implement a plan of action to end these abuses and believe that improving conditions at Yiuwah would mark an important change in the way Disney handles its supply chain.
